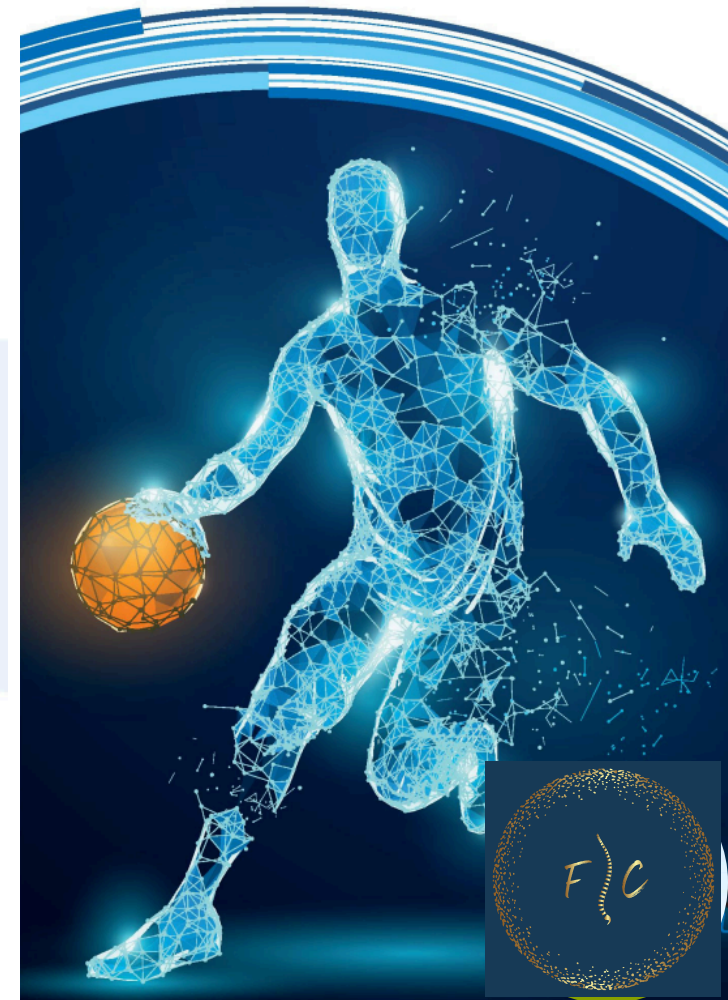

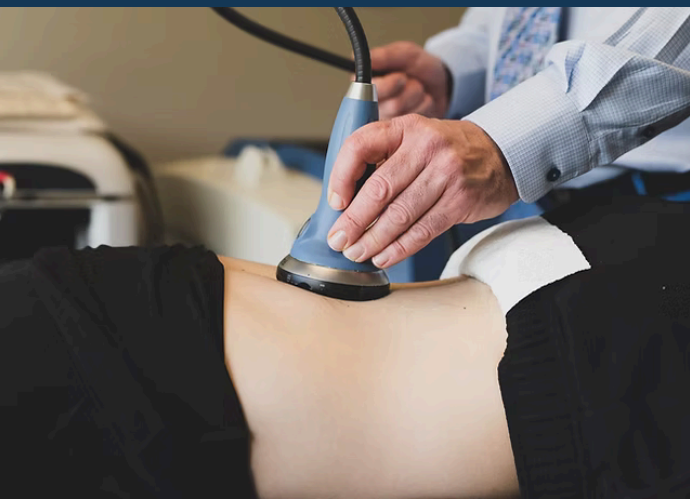

How Piezowave Therapy Works

Piezowave uses advanced acoustic waves to target pain at its source. These waves travel through your body and focus on a specific spot deep within the soft tissue.

This creates a precise, intense, and short-duration compression that directly addresses the affected area.

Target the True Source of Your Pain

Did you know that the pain you feel isn't always coming from where it seems? This is called referred pain—when the source of the pain is in one area, but you feel it somewhere else.

Piezowave therapy uses focused soundwaves to pinpoint and treat the root cause. With your feedback during treatment, we can target the exact areas that need care, helping you achieve lasting relief.

What To Expect During Piezowave Treatment:

Your Chiropractic Therapy Assistant will locate the treatment area and apply a gel to help the sound waves penetrate deeply. The session starts at a low setting and adjusts based on your comfort.

Most patients describe the sensation as a deep, dull ache. Treatment is tailored to your needs, and you can typically resume normal activities the same day. Any necessary restrictions will be explained by your provider.

How Long Does Treatment Take?
